Sermon Series: Glimpses of Jesus' Glory

Sermon No. Eight: "What Jesus Prays for His People"

"I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name-- the name you gave me-- so that they may be one as we are one. While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. None has been lost except the one born to destruction so that Scripture would be fulfilled."

John 17:11-12

1. THE EXPERIENCE AHEAD – "Still in the world"

Cosmos – Ordered (Physical, Human, Moral, Temporal, Eternal) – Organized without and against God

If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. (John 15:19)

2. THE EXPRESSION OF HIS HEART – "Protect them"

A. From the World – "Do not be conformed any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." (Romans 12:1-2)

Father is not in them. For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever. (1 John 2:15-17)

You adulterous people, don't you know that friendship with the world means enmity against God? Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. (James 4:4)

B. From Satan – "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one." (Matthew 6:13)

The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. (2 Cor. 4:4)
Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. (1 Peter 5:8)

...in order that Satan might not outwit us. For we are not unaware of his schemes. (2 Cor. 2:11)
